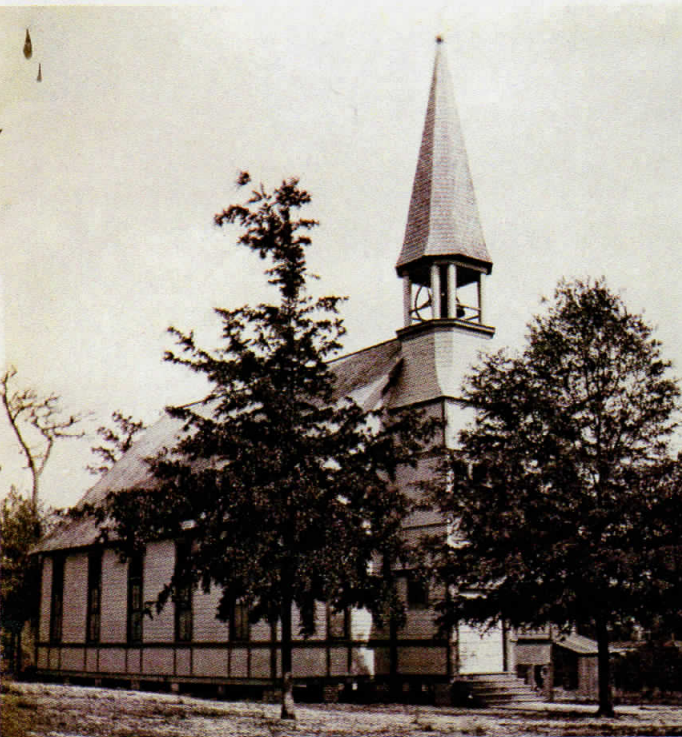


## A Selection 1904-1906 Church Photos...

These interesting photographs are from the private collection of Lucretia West and published here-in with her express permission.



Pictured on the upper-left is a view of the Church taken in 1904. There are some interesting features of this photograph when compared to the one shown on page 11. That photo was taken a number of years later but prior to exterior changes known to have occurred in 1914. The trees are more mature and an external bulletin board appears in the other photo.



Pictured on the upper-right is a view of the Church Vestibule showing the Church Choir and Organist posed on its steps. Although Donnelly Avenue does not yet appear paved in that area, the Church had installed a paved walkway at the entrance.



On the right, the photograph clearly shows the Pastor and Church Choir posing in the sophisticated dress of that era's Church attendees. It was significantly more formal than that seen on today's modern Church goers.
